Kylie Thorn, a representative from KAEFER Integrated Services connected with our Employment Services team in Darwin to provide assistance in the recruitment for their available positions.

With our support, Kylie will be conducting information sessions in early 2024 in search of approximately 30 individuals to join their scaffolding traineeship roles for the Inpex facility. Additionally, in April and May 2024, KAEFER will be seeking candidates for Traineeships and Apprenticeships.

KAEFER development involves 12 weeks of paid training at East Arm, transportation from designated muster points and following the training phase, participants will transition to the work site out at Inpex, where they will be working 10-hour shifts.

This approach is intended to gradually introduce individuals to the extended work hours.

Once the participants are deployed at the Inpex facility, we will continue to provide mentoring support on-site and explore the possibility of delivering additional training.

The youth from Alice Springs continue to work closely with the Team at Arrente Boxing with Jason, Dennis, Nick and Nathan.

This is an activity that the young people can choose to continue after they leave Saltbush to maintain fitness and focus on their personal wellbeing.
