



## RESIDENTIAL SUPPORT WORKER - CASUAL

As a Residential Support Worker you will be part of a dedicated and professional team that is responsible for successfully delivering comprehensive care to young people and assisting them to maintain their court ordered conditions such as bail, good behaviour order and suspended sentence and to improve their prospects of avoiding detention.

Ideally, you will have experience, understanding and success in working with disadvantaged youth and a working knowledge of Trauma Informed Care and strength-based approaches to working with young people

As an outcome focussed 'people person', and with the support of our passionate team, you will provide day-to-day home-style supervision and support of young people while they are in our care, aimed at assisting the young person to make better life choices.

If you have experience working in Youth, Community or Residential services, or in other roles that have given you a good understanding of this type of work, this could be the challenge you have been looking for.
